Ice gola vendor assaulted by six men over payment dispute in Ahmedabad



Ahmedabad. A 25-year-old ice gola vendor was allegedly assaulted by a group of six unidentified men in the early hours of Thursday at the Riverfront area in Ahmedabad. The accused, who reportedly objected to the vendor asking for payment for spoons the previous evening, attacked him with wooden sticks, leaving him with serious head and body injuries, police said. The victim, Shanti Chauhan, a resident of Mansarovar Society in Chandkheda, is currently undergoing treatment at the Civil Hospital, where he remains admitted with head and body injuries. According to the complaint filed at Vansu police station, the incident took place around 12.15 am on May 16.

Chauhan, who runs an ice gola cart along with his wife

and brother-in-law, stated that the previous evening, an unidentified man aged around 20-25, approached their cart near Vallabh Sadan at the Riverfront and demanded four spoons. When Chauhan asked for payment, the man allegedly refused, offering only 120 and using abusive language before leaving.

In his complaint, Chauhan alleged that later that night, six unidentified men, all aged between 20 and 25, arrived at the spot on two scooters. Two of them, both wearing white shirts and carrying wooden sticks, confronted Chauhan, accusing him of insulting their friend over spoon money. The group then allegedly attacked him with sticks, striking him repeatedly on head, back, hip, and legs, while hurling abuses. Chauhan stated that despite his brother-in-law

Abhishek and wife Rachna attempting to intervene, the attackers also assaulted a bystander who tried to rescue him.

The group fled the scene before emergency services arrived. Chauhan was rushed to the Civil Hospital by his wife and brother-in-law.

Doctors treating Chauhan noted deep injuries on his head requiring stitches, along with multiple injuries on his back, left hip, and right leg.

Based on Chauhan's complaint, Vansu police have registered a case against six unidentified persons under IPC sections for rioting, unlawful assembly, criminal intimidation, assault, and causing grievous hurt. "We are analysing CCTV footage from the area and trying to trace the accused based on the victim's description and the vehicles used," a senior officer said.

Pre-monsoon showers will continue to soak Gujarat, says IMD

The pre-monsoon showers refuse to leave Gujarat as the Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) has predicted unseasonal rainfall in several districts of the state for the next seven days. Some districts in Saurashtra, south and north Gujarat are likely to experience continued unseasonal rain for an entire week. Moreover, unseasonal rain is expected Saturday, in 13 districts of the state. "Light to Moderate rain or thundershowers is likely in Sabarkantha, Aravalli, Panchmahal, Dahod, Mahisagar, Vadodra, Chhotaudepur, Navsari, Bharuch, Surat, Gandhinagar, Valsad, Tapi, Daman, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Surendranagar, Rajkot, Junagadh, Amreli, Bhavnagar, Gir Somnath, Botad and Dui," said IMD.

At Ahmedabad, the maximum temperature on Friday remained at 38.8°C. Notably, Rajkot experienced an unseasonal rainfall, with around 1.5 inches pouring down in just 45 minutes, leading to widespread flooding across the city, on Wednesday.

Metal Prices Expected to Fluctuate on the LME between \$9000 and \$10200

Ahmedabad. According to a report by Motilal Oswal Financial Services, base metals have been caught in between supply surplus forecasts for most metals, weakening PMET figures, and constant updates on negotiations between US-China, keeping market participants on edge and uncertain about the future path. The US has been imposing tariffs continuously on its trade partners, while keeping rates high for Chinese imports—with tariffs on certain goods ranging up to 245%. However, China has been at the forefront of protecting its country's interests and is fighting back against the constant 'singling out' by the US. After making progress with the UK, the Trump administration also

took notable de-escalation measures with China to ease the economic hardship that both countries are beginning to experience. Copper has been witnessing high volatility—briefly touching levels above \$10,000 in March, then collapsing to around \$8,000 within a week, and rebounding to \$9,500. Following the news of Trump signing an executive order imposing a 25% tariff on US exports to China, the Department of Commerce to investigate whether copper imports threaten national security, potentially leading to a 25% tariff on these imports, a price disparity between LME and COMEX prices emerged. This created arbitrage opportunities, prompting speculative shipments and frontloading of planned deliveries to avoid potential tariffs. (1-39)

Ahmedabad. At its meeting today, the Board of Directors of Repco Home Finance Limited approved the financial results prepared as per Indian Accounting Standards (IND AS) for the quarter and financial year ended March 31, 2025.

The overall loan book stood at Rs. 14,492 crores at the end of March 31, 2025, as against Rs. 13,513 crores a year back. The AUM was Rs. 14,155 crores as of December 31, 2024. As of March 31, 2025, loans to the non-salaried segment accounted for 52% of the outstanding loan book and loans for salaried segment accounts for 48% of loan book. Housing loans accounted for 73% of the loans while Home Equity products accounted for 27% of the outstanding loan book. 100% of the loans given by the Company are retail loans.

New Great Game: Why Bharat kept Operation Sindoor 'focused', 'measured' and 'non-escalatory'

Fifteen days after the dastardly Pahalgam attack, in which 26 people were killed after being religiously profiled, Bharat has responded with striking terror targets in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) under Operation Sindoor.

Bharat precisely targeted infrastructure in Pakistan being used by terror outfits such as Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) and Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) for training terrorists and as hideouts. One of the major targets was the LeT headquarters in Muridke, a town near Lahore in Pakistan's Punjab province.

"Our actions have been focused to intensify the non-escalatory in nature," the government said in a released document. "No Pakistani military facilities have been targeted."

On the face of it, the April 22 Pahalgam attack appears to be a typical Pakistani plot to keep Bharat bleeding and boiling. The timing seems appropriate too. The military under Gen Asim Munir has been on the back foot, given the challenge it, as an institution, has received from Imran Khan, who continues to remain the most popular Pakistani despite being in jail.

To make things worse, the condition in Balochistan is worsening by the day, and so is the situation in Pakistan's wild tribal border. Since nothing unites a divided Pakistan better than Bharat, Pahalgam fits in Islamabad's jihadi jigsaw. Gen Munir's two-nation statement too points in the direction.

However, there has been more to Pahalgam than meets the eye, and a closer scrutiny exposes a far more sinister plot: the growing Chinese footprint in the Pakistani military structure. It seemed as if it were Chinese hands pulling up Pakistani bullets, hoping

that Bharat would react in a jiffy—thus losing the war plot and global sympathy. Delhi, realising the Chinese subversion, took the slow path to retaliation, avoiding the civilian and military installations and instead focusing on hardcore jihadi centres.

This explains why after two weeks of no kinetic action against Pakistan, except, of course, the suspension of the 1950 Indo-Pak Treaty, Bharat's response has been "focused, measured and non-escalatory in nature". By confining the attack to terror centres in Pakistan and PoK, Delhi has thrown the long-term war back to Islamabad's court. If the generals of Rawalpindi retaliate, they would be accused of pushing the escalatory button, and if they don't, the Pakistan Army would further lose its sagging reputation.

The long-term warfare also makes sense for Bharat when its adversary has fewer economic resources and limited military wherewithal to take on its eastern neighbour. The longer the war continues, the weaker Pakistan gets. Another reason to go slow could be the supposed affinity of the Pakistan Air Force with Rafale. After all, in the recently held multinational air warfare competition, the Pakistan Air Force came out as the winner. In Saudi Arabia, Pakistan's JF-17 Block-III had trained with France-made Rafale jets.

Be that as it may, Bharat, by not rushing with the kinetic action and then confining the attack to terror centres, has kind of checked the Chinese plot. In any way, Pakistan, the decade has confined itself to being a Chinese colony, badly stuck as it is in Beijing's never-ending debt trap. Islamabad's external debt to China alone accounts for 22 per cent of its total external

debt. With Pakistan's total public debt at 74.3 per cent of the country's GDP, Beijing's economic control over Islamabad is absolute.

To add to it, China Beijing is also Pakistan's largest arms supplier. Between 2010 and 2019, it supplied 70 per cent of Pakistan's arms imports, worth over \$5 billion. And between 2017 and 2021, 47 per cent of China's total global arms exports went to Pakistan. Given Pakistan's jihadi nature, it's obvious that sooner than later these military devices will find their way to terrorists. An intelligence report last year said that Pakistan-based terrorist outfits such as Jaish-e-Mohammed and Lashkar-e-Taiba were using Chinese weapons and equipment.

The Chinese plot thickens when one listens to the recent statement by the Chinese Ambassador to Pakistan Jia Wang, who, after meeting President Asif Ali Zardari, reaffirmed the "enduring" and "time-tested friendship" between the two countries, describing the relationship as one of "fraternal brothers" who have always supported each other in challenging times.

There is a dominant thinking in Xi Jinping's China that Bharat's rise has to be challenged and stopped. If this is not done immediately, it might be too late. What further ripples the Chinese leadership is the emergence of Donald Trump in America openly challenging the Chinese worldview. The Xi administration is watching with great unease the coming together of Modi's Bharat and Trump's America. China believes that its global ambition will be imperilled if the two powers come together.

This distrust for Trump and Modi is also pushing Europe closer to China. Europe has



traditionally been anti-Russia and is equally uneasy with Bharat's rise. And now with Trump's willingness to shift the American pivot eastward towards Asia and also engage with Putin, he has majorly upset the Western European powers that just can't fathom the idea of losing their position at the high global diplomatic table.

The statement by the EU's top diplomat, Kaja Kallas, urging Bharat and Pakistan "to show restraint and pursue dialogue to ease the situation", adding, "Escalation helps no one", should be seen in this light. The statement shows the EU's double standards, especially when it is willing to show no such restraint on the Ukraine issue. In fact, Kallas herself is on record seeking a strong action against Russia. "I hope in the long term, be harming its own cause, Bharat has done well to see Pahalgam not just through the prism of Pakistan but as the result of a sinister plan made by a coalition of nations led by China, supported by Turkey, and given covering fire by the Western European nations. America, too, needs to wake up to this emerging challenge. Bharat may be the first major stop for Xi Jinping's China, but America will be the first frontier. There is no hope for America without the rise of Bharat."

Then, of course, there is Turkey, ever eager to take up the mantle of the Caliphate of the Islamic world. It has already made a few discordant voices against Bharat. Delhi will have to consider deadly drones and a few other military equipment from Turkey falling into Pakistani hands. It's, however, America

that poses the biggest dilemma for Bharat. As the saying goes, "To be an enemy of the US is dangerous, but to be a friend is fatal." Trump is trying to change this American characteristic. Here, it needs to be understood that if Bharat needs the US to check the sinister Chinese design, the Americans too cannot defeat Beijing without Delhi.

(Trump also needs to mend America's ties with Russia, for Putin can be a long-term ally.) China, in fact, is the biggest stumbling block to Pax Americana, and it can be stopped by the US only in the company of Bharat. The US-led world order can withstand the Chinese assault only when Bharat is there, strong and assertive. If the US lets Bharat down after the Pahalgam attack, it would, in the long term, be harming its own cause. Bharat has done well to see Pahalgam not just through the prism of Pakistan but as the result of a sinister plan made by a coalition of nations led by China, supported by Turkey, and given covering fire by the Western European nations. America, too, needs to wake up to this emerging challenge. Bharat may be the first major stop for Xi Jinping's China, but America will be the first frontier. There is no hope for America without the rise of Bharat.
